Coffee Shop is open in the Clulow Room in the Parish Centre every Wednesday from 10am to 11.30am. It is run by pairs of the 9 volunteers on a rota.

Tea, coffee, a choice of cake and scones are available at very reasonable prices. The profits are given to charity.

Since Covid and the cancellation of the regular health walk starting from the church car park numbers attending has severely dropped. Once as low as 3 but more often 8 to 12 people enjoying good company.

Coffee Shop is advertised in the Pew Sheet, on notice boards in and outside the church and in church service notices. A very welcoming advert appears in the Comet and there is a poster in the Love Letchworth shop window in the Arcade in the town centre.
