6. **VICAR'S REPORT** As there is no report this year Neil Greatorex reported from the listening exercise conducted by Bishop Jane and Rural Dean Bill. The five points that emerged from this are:

- There is a culture of challenging behaviour in the church,
- Communication needs to improve,
- The Vicar's workload should be addressed.
- Support for the vicar needs to be in place.
- There is a fall in the numbers of children in the children's ministry

A copy of the report with an attached letter from the bishop is available to all in the Parish to look at and work on.

The PCC are going to work with an external consultant to improve the culture at church

7. **FINANCE:** Carol Greatorex presented the main points from the Treasurer's report

- The church is in profit of £11,000 this has been heavily supported by a legacy
- The income from the parish hall has increased.
- There has been high investment into the house in Common View, so the accommodation is up to standard, also in the parish hall
- There is a drop in stewardship giving due to a loss of significant givers
- Utilities have gone up significantly.
- We have received an £8,000 grant from the Heritage for the maintenance of the St George's spire.

Thanks were expressed, by Keith Taylor, to Carol and Neil for all the hard work they do with the finances. All agreed.

The audited accounts for the year ending 31/12/2022 were accepted by the meeting.

8. AUDITOR

Carol proposed we ask Robin Mead to audit the accounts again next year. Fiona Eve seconded and all agreed.
